Queen Street Mill Textile Museum

In 1886 Burnley produced more cotton cloth than anywhere else in the world and made more looms than any other place in the country it was the place where 'King Cotton' ruled. At Queen Street Mill Textile Museum you can step back in time to experience life in a Victorian cotton mill; hear the deafening sound of over 300 Lancashire looms powered by the magnificent steam engine 'PEACE', see how the cloth is woven and learn all about the secret language of the weavers' and tacklers. The 'Simply Textile' range of gifts is available in the shop and tea will be served in the museums café.
